Peter Sunderland is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Fire Protection Engineering at the University of Maryland, a position he has held since 2004. Previously he was Staff Scientist at NASA Glenn Research Center. His degrees are from Cornell University (B.S.), the University of Massachusetts (M.S.), and the University of Michigan (M.S. and Ph.D.). His research interests are in combustion and fire protection. His specializations include soot formation, laminar flames, hydrogen fire safety, oxygen-enhanced combustion, microgravity combustion, and experimental methods. His current research is funded by NASA and NIST. He has taught courses on diffusion flames, fluid mechanics, and engineering design.
